 - 1. Jesus did not fear His death Heb 13:12-14; Jhn 10:15-18
 - 2. We can have boldness Eph 3:12
 - 3. Franklin Roosevelt: "We have nothing to fear, but fear itself."
- D. Some only see problems in coming year. Num 13:31

III. THROUGH AND WITH CHRIST I CAN SERVE GOD

- A. Our faith must prompt us to serve God
- B. Our faith is nothing if it does not prompt us to serve the Lord with all our might. Jas 1:22; 2:18; Eccl 9:10
- C. God has set before us a race to run, a victors crown to win.
 - 1. We are not spectators. 1Cor 9:24,25
 - 2. Race must be run with patience Heb 12:1
- D. We must run the race in 2014, so that we will not be ashamed to meet the Lord. 2Tim 4:7

IV. THROUGH AND WITH CHRIST MUCH CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED

- A. We must not limit what can be done
- B. Both individuals and church have much to do this year.
 - 1. We suffer but God's love sustains us Rom 8:36-39
 - 2. God will help us do what we can Eph 3:20
- D. A little bit of faith can go a long way. Matt 17:20
- E. Knowing God hears us gives confidence 1Jhn 5:14-15

V. THROUGH AND WITH CHRIST WE CAN HAVE SUCCESS

- A. Jesus will help us 2Tim 4:14-18; Heb 13:6
- B. However, to have his help we must continue to abide in Him Jhn 15:5-8
- C. We must put His kingdom first Matt 6:33
